With University funding likely to be cut by central government in response to the current recession, it has been decided to freeze PineSoft prices at January 2008 levels.

 - Version 12 is fully compatible with Access 2010, so there are no issues should your university move from Office 2007 to Office 2010.
 - Version 11 will continue to be fully supported and developed for users who wish to maintain the best compatibility with Office 2003/XP.
